The meeting of Clark Borough Council was called to order by President, James Carucci who led in the pledge to the flag on Tuesday, April 4, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. Others in attendance were Russell Shaffer, Donna Lapikas, Lee Loutzenhiser, Douglas Robbins, Clark Eberhart, William Madden, Barbara Dunlap, Bob Tomko and Scott Sigworth.

Douglas Robbins made a motion to accept the March 7, 2017 minutes. The motion was seconded by Russell Shaffer, and passed with all voting yes.

James Carucci read the Treasurer's Report for the Month of March 2017. Clark Eberhart made a motion to accept the March 2017 Treasurer's Report. This motion was seconded by Russell Shaffer and passed with all present voting yes.

Douglas Robbins asked Attorney Madden about the process of changing school system from Sharpville Area School to the Hermitage School district.

James Carucci asked if there were any further questions for Attorney Madden. No questions were raised and Attorney Madden was then excused from the meeting.

Clark Eberhart read the Sewer Committee Bills. Clark Eberhart made a motion to accept the bills as read. Russell Shaffer seconded the motion and the motion passed with all voting yes.
