The meeting of Clark Borough Council was called to order by Douglas Robbins who led in the pledge of allegiance to the flag on Tuesday, July 11, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. Others in attendance were Mary Jo Harakal, Clark Eberhart, Russell Shaffer, Donna Lapikas, Lee Loutzenhiser, Patti LaRocca, Attorney William Madden, Barbara Dunlap, Larry McKnight, and Scott Sigworth.

Russell Shaffer made a motion to accept the July 11, 2017 minutes. The motion was seconded by Clark Eberhart, and passed with all voting yes.

Douglas Robbins read the Treasurer's Report Clark Eberhart made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report as read. This motion was seconded by Donna Lapikas and passed with all present voting yes.

Douglas Robbins recognized visitors Dr. Joseph and Tom Joseph, Douglas Robbins and asked if they wished to address Council. Dr. Joseph stated that they were attending the meeting as observers.

Unfinished business, Borough has received Certificate of liability insurance from the Reinhardt's Agency concerning the Joad Archery program.
