Minutes of the Clark Borough Special Meeting - August 24, 2021 6:00PM

The meeting of the Clark borough council was called to order by counsel Present Jim Carucci who led in the pledge to the flag on Tuesday, August 24, 2021 at 6 PM. New Business

Doug Robbins made a motion to award S/S Line and Strip the line painting project and deduct \$736 from Landfried Paving's Invoice for the painting portion of their bid pending approval from Landfried Paving and/or legal advice from Attorney Madden. The motion was seconded by Clark Eberhart and passed with a roll call vote of: Carucci – yes, Eberhart – yes, Robbins – yes, McConahy – yes, Yeatts – yes, Simko – yes, McKnight – yes pending legal advice approval.

Correspondence

Maryjo Harakal read correspondence from Winslow Engineering regarding heavy rainfall that caused the interceptor to overflow at the manhole in the USACOE open field.

Maryjo Harakal read correspondence from Attorney Madden regarding the vacant council seat.

Maryjo Harakal stated that the storage containers on Dr. Joseph's empty lot can now be assessed taxes due to being on the property for over one year. Zoning Officer, Al Harakal is to confirm the amount of containers and size before sending the Tax Assessment request for to the courthouse.
